Her cover album *Valentine* reached number 6 on an iTunes chart. Just as Evie turned 15 Delta Airlines used her single in their holiday commercial and she was the headliner for a 72 show run at the El Dorado Hotel in Reno, Nevada with cirque acts from all over the world. She has been featured by Billboard, USA Today, MSN, Fox News, Today, Google, The Washington Post among other national news media. Her first America's Got Talent audition video posted on YouTube had the 3rd highest view count in the world for 2018. Evie is still a performer, motivational speaker, songwriter and manages to keep up with nearly a half million amazing fans. Keep an eye out for big things to come from this rising star.
